Pre-Development

• Up to \$50,000 per project is available to determine the viability of residential development on a particular site. Funds are available on a rolling basis.

Development

- Up to \$75,000-\$100,000 per unit to support the development of affordable and community housing for both rental and homeownership units.
- Up to \$200,000 per unit if the project meets the qualifications for a priority category outlined in the NOFA.
- Maximum of \$2,000,000 per project.
