MINUTES

March 9, 2011 – 6:00 pm Town Hall, Hearing Room

Present: Laura F. Shufelt, Hearing Officer, Cindy L. Dabkowski, Accessory Affordable Apartment Program Coordinator

- Hearing Officer Laura F. Shufelt called the meeting to order at 6:00 p.m.

Appeal No. 2010-041 – Jeffrey J. Camish Withdrawn without Prejudice

- The Hearing Officer read the legal ad as published in the Barnstable Patriot
- The hearing officer made Mr. Camish aware of the proposed conditions
- Jeffrey J. Camish gave his testimony.
- Members of the public were requested to comment. William C Chaprales spoke in opposition to an accessory apartment located at 21 Stone Bridge Lane Marstons Mills, Mr. Chaprales presented a Planning Board Special Permit for Open Space Development to the hearing Officer¹.
- Mr. Chaprales stated that the only use permitted on each lot in said development shall be single family dwellings as per the Special Permit.
- The applicant Jeffrey J. Camish requested that his application for an Accessory Unit be withdrawn.

Action: Comprehensive Permit No. 2010-041 – Camish is withdrawn without prejudice

Appeal No. 2008-059 – Gina M. Stewart Permit Rescinded

- The Hearing Officer read the legal ad as published in the Barnstable Patriot
- The applicant has not received an occupancy permit for the accessory unit.
- Gina M. Stewart did not attend the March 9, 2011 hearing.
- Ms Shufelt ruled to rescind Comprehensive Permit No. 2008-059 Gina M. Stewart

Action: Comprehensive Permit No. 2008-059 – Gina M. Stewart is rescinded
