Ms. Weber has been a long-time member of the Mid Cape Cultural Council and held the position of Chair. Due to the guidelines of the membership Massachusetts General Laws Part I. Administration of the Government (Ch. 1-182) Ch. 10, § 58, Members of the local and regional cultural council shall be appointed for staggered terms of three years, and any such member shall not be appointed to more than two consecutive terms. Members shall have demonstrated scholarship or creativity in, or distinguished service to, the arts, humanities, or interpretive sciences. Ms. Weber took a year off after her consecutive term and is now allowed to apply again.

Committee members voted to recommend John Murphy from an associate position to a full member position to a term expiring 06/30/2029 on the Licensing Authority

Committee members voted to recommend Conrad Watson from an alternate member to a full member position, to a term expiring 06/30/2028 on the Hyannis Main Street Waterfront Historic District Commission

Chair of Committee asked for a motion to adjourn this was made by Councilor Keane, seconded by Councilor Bloom, all members present voted to adjourn.
