# Luke's Love – A Boundless Playground

Existing Conditions Reports from CBI Consulting Inc. *School Administration Building* 

- Building is in better shape than originally reported; extensive work still needed just not as detrimental at this time
- Trayser Museum complex
  - Also not as in depth as originally informed
- \* Members are advised to review the reports closely; and prepare comments and prioritization for discussion
- \* Reports are only preliminary
- \* Committee requests either a CD be made or for reports to be available on line some how; request for Theresa to investigate and facilitate access

#### Wellness Center

• Members formally request for remaining funds on this project be returned to the Housing Line Item in CPA funds

#### Historic Projects

- Members agree that the Historic Consultant should review historic applications; but only after the letter of interest has been received and reviewed for CPA applicability by members, definitely prior to request for application
- Discussion on 'halting' applications for historic funding; needs further review; emergency applications would be taken under consideration
