The applicant was represented by Attorney Stephen Pizutti and Lynne Hamlyn.

Staff provided some of the background with regard to the case, and the outcome of recent settlement negotiations. Mr. Pizutti said that a new bathymetric study would be completed. Draft restrictions were suggested of 9" on boat #1, and 12" on boat #2.

All standard conditions lacking in the original Order of Conditions would be applied in the Amended Order.

The Commission expressed its interest in the removal of all unauthorized balusters on the pier.

A motion was made to table the certificate of compliance request to February 9, 2010, and to refer the revised pier and draft restrictions to the January 5, 2010 meeting as a request for an Amended Order of Conditions.

Seconded and voted unanimously.
