DIRECTOR'S REPORT: The budget for operating expenses will be voted on in June and the needs assessment is part of it. The parking lot should be done in the fall of 2015. However, additional funding for the outreach department was not accepted. The solar system will be finished by June 30, 2014. Will be hiring a new staff member for the position of a supportive aid for the ASDC. Funding for the SC is basically level. The SC receives .29% of 1% of the town budget. Memorial Day celebration will be on May 22, 2014. Open house will be on June 20, 2014. The antique quilt raffle will take place during the open house.

FBCOA LIAISON: Gary Sylvester-Paul Curley. The new board is very positive and directed. They are working on the cookbook as a fund raiser for the SC.
