

Minutes of BCOA Meeting

March 20, 2024

The BC OA meeting was called to order by John Jope at 9:00 AM. There were five board members, and two guests present.

Housekeeping: John confirmed that Elaine Ryan has resigned from the Council. However, two new applicants have applied for the Council which will bring the total voting members to nine once they have been approved by the Town Council.

John presented the basics of parliamentary procedures to the board.
