Hyannis Master Plan Status and Discussion: Bruce McIntyre

- Richard Mandell plans on being in Hyannis on Tuesday May 27<sup>th</sup>, the goal would be to set up a meeting with Richard and Town of Barnstable Management it may be tough with year end near and budget review
- We may have an extra meeting with Richard non committee related more like our focus groups we had in the winter
- Richard Aliberti asked if he considered night lights into his plan
- Edin Nacar expressed how some people he has been golfing with actually thought that this is going to happen.
- Bruce explained we need to set people straight and this is going to be a long process and we will need the full support of the membership

Refreshment Carts Status: Bruce McIntyre

- The refreshment cart is operational at Hyannis Golf Course. The Barnstable Youth Hockey tournament was this past Monday and it was received very well.
- OBF is still in the works to be operational this summer. Philbricks restaurant is also starting a mobile app that you can order from.

Committee Initiatives for FY'15:

Chair Miller asks the committee to present any initiatives they would like to talk about for FY15

- Chair Miller suggested the financial implications of the master plan should be an initiative for FY 15
- Edin Nacar asked about the bathrooms at Hyannis Golf Course
- Bruce explained that it has been approved by the Town Council for \$85k CIP for FY 15 and that we will try to start the work January 2015 after the Holidays
- Mary Creighton asked what can we the committee can do to help drum up the outside tournament business

Manager/Superintendent Report: Bruce McIntyre

- Our long time financial supervisor Lisa Peterson is retiring at the end of this fiscal year. She will be working into the first week of July to assist in to closing of year end and cross training a new person. We wish her the best of luck she has been a fantastic employee and has done a fantastic job.
- Golf Destination TV on NESN will be running a show on May 26<sup>th</sup> at 6pm and 10pm and June 1<sup>st</sup> at 5pm featuring Barnstable Golf.
- There will be a Special Olympics clinic held at Hyannis Golf Course
- We had our 375<sup>th</sup> Anniversary Town of Barnstable Golf day May 12<sup>th</sup> at Olde Barnstable there were 56 golfers that took advantage of the \$37.50 special we ran. Next Monday May 19<sup>th</sup> we are having the same special at Hyannis Golf Course greens fee, cart and small bucket of balls for \$37.50
- Ed Hickey asked about the public transportation and if there is any in the Town of Barnstable that golfers can use to get to course to take advantage of these specials if for example they were to come over on the ferry from the islands.
  - Chair Miller explained the RTA will take you anywhere you request within a certain route
- Roman Greer and David Donnellan attended a First Tee program in Connecticut and are now First Tee certified coaches
- James Bentley is now a certified pesticide applicator category 37 Turf Specialty James and I are the only ones certified at this level
- All greens and tees were aerated and top dressed the end of April, the courses are good to go.
- Today was the Ladies Club Opening Day event here at OBF we had 44 ladies play
- First fertilization will take place at both courses this week, we only do the roughs once a year and the fairways twice a year
- The Men's two day Member-Member tournament sign up is available for sign up
- Edward Hickey had a few questions about the reports that are emailed
  - Bruce explained how and why we forecast and project the numbers
- Edin Nacar asked if there has been any thought of bringing a large tournament to the cape.
  - Bruce: we would love to have a USGA Junior National Championship
