Act on Minutes from the June Meeting Motion duly made by Mary Creighton to approve the minutes of the 6/10/2014 meeting. Seconded by Nancy Beauchamp Vote: so voted unanimously

**Public Comments** 

John Reed: Retired teacher from Barnstable Public School and the Vice President of the Cape Cod branch of the NAACP. Mr. Reed is concerned about the cost and availability of the First Tee Program and he has not had any communication from the Town of Barnstable First Tee Program.

Joe Daluz: Also from the NAACP expressed how he thinks communication between adults can be difficult at times and people just can't get together at times. Joe references a letter<sup>1</sup> from Bruce McIntyre and hands out copies to the committee and is confused by the lack of communication. Joe expressed he is here for the game of golf and the kids and he wants his program recognized.

Bruce McIntyre introduces himself to the attendees and expressed how he has received no communication from the group that John and Joe are referring to. Bruce gives a brief history of the First Tee and the Town of Barnstable. The First Tee at the Town of Barnstable has never turned away anyone who could not pay the fee. The letter was mainly in defense of the successful First Tee program we have created.

Richard Aliberti questioned Bruce about who he reached out to in the group. Bruce said he spoke to Keith Clarke who provided a contact, however, not in enough time to participate in the groups meetings. Joe Daluz added that David Scudder resigned from the original First Tee Committee

Richard Aliberti requests the chair to allow him to read in letters from the past about the First Tee Joe Daluz again added that there seems to be some confusion between the groups and hopes we can get past this

John Reed also added that there seems to be issues with who runs what

Chair Miller explains that this is an advisory board and if I can cut to the chase when Twin Brooks got involved the exclusive rights to the First Tee Golf Course Program are at the Hyannis Golf Course. In the future I see no problem here.

Mary Creighton nominates Nancy Beauchamp for vice chair. Nancy appreciates the nomination but has to decline for various reasons.

## Hyannis Master Plan Status-

Bruce – At this point we have reviewed and made changes to the plan and sent it back to Richard Mandell. Once we receive the final draft back we will have a meeting with the Town Manager, Golf Staff, Richard Mandell and Chair Miller to go over the report Chair Miller shares his possible changes

-Increase the outside greens fee at OBF \$1 May thru September

-Increase the resident greens fee \$1 May thru September

-Increase Membership and add a improvement assessment

-Make the tee times earlier during the peak season

-Close OBF for a shorter time during the winter

-Agrees with keeping OBF open longer

-Increase the young adult pass

-Raise the non member cart fee

-Not ready to make any suggestions

-Agrees with the fees suggests possibility of adding a twilight members and possibly lowering the ceiling on the young adult pass

#### Manager/Superintendent Report: Bruce McIntyre

-In a letter received from Mark Milne about the possible capital assessment fee, it would need Town Manager approval.

-It would be better to just put any surplus money into the surplus fund and not use it until we had a reason

Rates:

-Increase the greens fee and cart to \$87.50 at Olde Barnstable

-No increase of greens fees at Hyannis

-Start a public only day at each course the generate more greens fees, one day in the spring and one day in the fall

-Small fee increase on the leagues at Hyannis

-Revise outing contract to reflect increased fees

-Squeeze more primetime tee times on the tee sheet my moving tee times up about 15 minutes on Saturday and Sunday during our prime tee times

-Annual pass increase

Mary Creighton compliments the staff at Hyannis on the new system with the carts on the weekend and the name tags are a nice touch
