### **Staff Report:**

### Nina Coleman addressed the Board:

- The beach is open 1.5 miles just west of trail 2. Some more area may open soon. Five nests past trail 2. Some terns.
- Cottagers can go up trail 1.
- Note: Sandy Neck Beach has the most ORV beach area available out of all the Cape beaches. Over July 4<sup>th</sup> weekend had 1.6 miles open.
- July 4<sup>th</sup> weekend was a beautiful weekend. Very busy with few incidents. Some minor problems. On the weekend had 250 campers and 550 chase vehicles or day trippers for a total of 800 vehicles. No day trippers were turned away.
- The sand bars on the point were patrolled. Extra staff checking for (1) illegal shellfishing (2) illegal people in the dunes (3) dogs not on leash. Dogs must be leashed at all times. A letter went out to all slip holders, and mooring holders reminding them of these rules.
- Jr. Ranger program started this week.
