#### I. CALL TO ORDER:

Chairman John Meade called the meeting to order at 7:05pm.

#### II. MINUTES:

Motion was made and approved to accept the minutes of September 23, 2008 and October 7, 2008.

#### III. NOTICES OF INTENT (NOI):

Mystic Lake – Barnstable Conservation – No objections.

Bonnybrook Pier – 185 Ocean View Ave, Cotuit (change of conditions) –  
No objections' providing that it doesn't extend beyond the outside

plane of the dock.

#### IV. MOORING APPEALS:

None.

#### V. OLD BUSINESS:

Eric Shufelt proposed changes in the Marina fees to the Committee:

Bismore Park Marina to increase 3% p/f.

Barnstable Harbor slips 1-34 increase 5% p/f,

slips 35-70 and Small Craft increase 10% p/s.

Gateway Marina to increase 10% p/s.

The Marina at Prince Cove increase 5% p/f.

Propose Mooring Regulation changes will be discussed in a workshop on 11/18.

#### VI. NEW BUSINESS:

Lewis Bay Research Center presentation to restore the natural channel behind Egg Island. The US Army Corp. of Engineers agreed to restore the channel for Yarmouth which will benefit both towns.

Proposed Dinghy Regulation – Ropes Beach. The proposed test area will be at Ropes Beach. No vessels shall be on the Town property at Ropes Beach between November 15 and April 15. Any remaining vessels will be removed during that time. There is a pending Town Manager's hearing on November 13<sup>th</sup>. If this works, it will be expanded to the other Town landings.

#### VII. CORRESPONDENCE:

From DEP regarding applicant Cape Wind Associates giving public notice to construct and maintain 2 sub-marine electric transmission cables and associated fiber optic cables within Barnstable and Yarmouth, Lewis Bay and Nantucket Sound. There is a public hearing on November 5 at the Mattakeese Middle School in Yarmouth.

VIII. HARBORMASTER REPORT:

Eric Shufelt reported that the new building at Bismore Park is nearly complete. It will be closed to the public for the winter as it is a seasonal building.

IX. ADJOURNMENT:

The meeting adjourned at 9:00pm.
