#### V. OLD BUSINES:

\*Proposed Mooring Regulation changes – amended/approved:

Added to 406-7 Placements of Moorings

F. A permit holders mooring and buoy must be placed and maintained in the water in its permitted location on or before July 1<sup>st</sup> of each year and remain in the water until September 1<sup>st</sup> of each year. Failure to comply with the placement requirements set above shall be grounds for revocation or non renewal of the mooring permit.

Added to 406-18 Mooring Servicers

M. All mooring and mooring buoys (tackle) must be placed in the water in its permitted location on or before July  $1^{st}$  of each year and <u>not</u> removed prior to September  $1^{st}$  of each year.

Add Non Designated Mooring Area Policy as a section to the regulations.

\*Proposed Dinghy Regulation – Ropes Beach –

Postcards were mailed to mooring holders in the Ropes Beach area explaining the new "Regulation of Vessels on Ropes Beach". Temporary signs have been posted (permanent signs coming soon) explaining vessel use there, it has also been on channel 18 as well as in local newspapers.

#### VI. NEW BUSINESS:

Cotuit Oyster Co. Shellfish Grant transfer to Christopher Gargiulo (the new president of Cotuit Oyster Co.) – No objections.

Waitlist renewals will be mailed on December 31<sup>st</sup>.
