### New Business:

Stuart Rapp addressed the committee with regard potential for new 2 acre shellfish grants. The Shellfish Committee is proposing approximately 28 acres of new shellfish aquaculture licensed sites in Barnstable Harbor west of the current shellfish aquaculture zone. No objections were found by the committee.

Patti Machado addressed the committee asking permission to place a floating dock on a currently permitted mooring issued to Town of Barnstable Recreation Sailing program. The floating dock will be used in a similar capacity as the Hyannis Yacht Club floats, to secure four 420 sailboats. No objections were found by the committee.

### Notice of Intent (NOI):

1. Town of Barnstable- Barnstable Inner Harbor Town Marina, permit of floats and reconfiguration zone. Reconfigure on the footprint of the dredge, permit and Chapter 91 license what is there today and potential for any added slips in the future. Due to the trend of smaller boating, this will provide flexibility to maximize the use of the marina. No objections from the committee as presented. (Copies available at 1189 Phinney's Lane).

2. Clara Mesonero - 464 Starboard Lane, Osterville. Proposed dock modifications include removal of the outermost 8-foot section and replacement with a new 8' wide by 10' dock section. No objections from the committee as presented. . (Copies available at 1189 Phinney's Lane).

**Harbor Master Report:**

Mooring permits and mooring waitlist renewal applications were mailed out the beginning of January, reminding all of the new deadline dates being moved up. Mooring permit renewals are due back by February 28<sup>th</sup>. The waitlist renewal applications are due back by February 15<sup>th</sup>. Also a reminder to the committee of the new fees implemented this year.

Eric Shufelt also stated that the marina waitlists were mailed out January 1<sup>st</sup> and are due back February 15<sup>th</sup>. The boat slip renewals were mailed out January 1<sup>st</sup> with deposits being due by January 31<sup>st</sup>.
