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Background

Barnstable Municipal Airport is located at 480 Barnstable Road in Hyannis. The airport is owned by the Town of Barnstable and is managed by the Barnstable Municipal Airport Commission. The airport provides flight services to Boston, New York and the islands.

Barnstable Municipal Airport is a two-story building connected by an elevator and two (2) sets of egress stairs located on each side of the ticketing hall. There are two (2) main entrances/exits to the airport located on the west side of the building; an additional entrance/exit is located near the car rental service counters. On the east side of the building, there are two (2) exits used by departing passengers, one (1) entrance used by arriving passengers and two (2) entrances used by airport personnel. Additional entrances/exits are located on the north side, the south side and at one (1) emergency exit from the boarding area.

The airport features airline ticket counters, car rental counters, an art gallery, a conference room and a café (closed the day of the survey) on the first floor. Airport staff offices are located on the first and second floors. Multi-user men's and women's toilet rooms are located near the café, the baggage claim area and the boarding area on the first floor. Staff multi-user toilet rooms are located on the second floor. The parking lot is located on the west side of the building; there are eight (8) accessible parking spaces near arrivals and six (6) accessible parking spaces near departures. The parking lot for the rental cars is located on the north side of the building and staff parking is located on the south side. A passenger loading zone and a bus stop shelter are located near one of the main entrances (west side).

Note: IHCD team was told that airport personnel requested more accessible parking spaces.

Key Accessibility Issues

Parking Lots, Passenger Loading Zone and Bus Shelter Accessibility issues at the parking lots include lack of an identification sign at one of the accessible parking spaces located near departures, lack of the minimum clear width at one of the access aisles at the accessible parking space located near arrivals and lack of the International Symbol of Accessibility (ISA) at the passenger loading zone. Accessibility issues at the bus shelter include lack of a clear ground space within the shelter next to the bench.

Interior Routes Accessibility issues include lack of the minimum required width at the accessible route near the seating area in the boarding area. TV monitors that protrude into the circulation path, and a fire pipe valve that lacks a cane-detectable barrier (Stair #1 on the 2nd floor). There are also drinking fountains for standing users that lack a cane-detectable barrier and therefore protrude into the circulation path.

Signage

Accessibility issues include lack of tactile signs (with braille and raised characters) at the accessible exits, egress signs not located on the latch side of the door, lack of the illuminated International Symbol of Accessibility (ISA) at egress doors leading directly to an accessible exit and directional signs mounted lower than the minimum required.

Best Practice and Inclusive Design

Best practice and inclusive design recommendations include elements that are not required in the standards but may create enhanced experiences for all users.

- Recommend adding contrasting strips at the edge of each step at all interior and exterior stairs.
- Recommend providing an adjustable podium with knee and toe clearance (conference room).
- Recommend locating wayside closer to the walkway (near car rental and arrivals).
- Recommend providing a directional sign near Room #236 (2nd floor).
- Recommended providing a gate surface within 10" of the finished floor on the push side of the gate (café area).
- Recommend relocating the sign located at the airport staff offices (Room #223 on the 2nd floor) to avoid glare.
