# Town of Barnstable **ADA Transition Plan**

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### Background

Osterville Community Center is located at 1<sup>st</sup> Avenue in Osterville. The Community Center features a meeting room with a kitchenette, an office, a gymnasium, and men's and women's toilet rooms. The meeting room is currently used for dog training programs. Exterior amenities include two (2) tennis courts, a baseball field, a playground and a parking lot. There are 18 parking spaces including two (2) accessible spaces.

Note: IHCD team was told that the Town wants to demolish the building and rebuild a new Community Center within the next year or two. Plans for the new facility have been drafted, and the project is in the process of receiving funding for construction.

The Community Center is a single-story building with a main entrance/exit located on the west side of the building. There are two (2) inaccessible exits from the gymnasium (northwest and northeast sides).

### **Key Accessibility Issues**

### Playground and Areas of Sport Activity

Accessibility issues at the playground include lack of an accessible route to and around the playground and lack of an impact-attenuating accessible surface to, under and around the play elements within the playground. Also, of concern is the lack of an accessible route that connects all the exterior amenities. If the baseball field is used again an accessible route to the boundary of sport activity must be provided.

**Note:** The Massachusetts Architectural Access Board (MAAB) does not consider engineered wood fiber (EWF) to comply with its regulation requiring an accessible route to each play component and around the playground.

### **Toilet Rooms**

Accessibility issues include lack of maneuvering clearance at the entry to the women's toilet room, lack of turning space at the inside of the toilet rooms, and the accessible compartments lack

the minimum required width. Other accessibility issues include paper towel dispensers that protrude into the circulation paths, and lavatories that lack knee clearance, compliant faucets and insulated pipes.

### Additional Accessibility Issues

- main entrance.
- Lack of a compliant threshold at the main entrance/exit.

- Shelves that protrude into the circulation path (meeting room). Lack of tactile egress signs (raised characters and braille) and lack of directional signage at the inaccessible exits directing people to the nearest accessible exits.

### **Best Practice and Inclusive Design**

Best practice and inclusive design recommendations include elements that are not required in the standards but may create enhanced experiences for all users.

- Benches not located on an accessible route.
- Lack of an accessible work surface (meeting room).

• Costs for this facility are not provided since IHCD team was told that the building will soon be replaced.

- Costs to provide an impact-attenuating accessible surface to, under and around the play elements in the playground (poured-in-place rubber) are not provided. The material cost
  - for a poured in-place rubber surface is estimated to be \$14 a

- Recommend providing some benches with backs and some with arms near the playground and near the tennis court. • Recommend relocating the information located at the main entrance to avoid glare.
- Recommended providing a gate surface (kick plate) within 10" of the ground on the push side of the gate (tennis court).
