Barnstable Recreation Division Program Behavior & Discipline Procedure

Programs offered by the Barnstable Recreation Division are a privilege for the participants, therefore participants are expected to exhibit appropriate

behavior at all times. The staff will strive to provide a safe, fun, educational and secure environment for all participants. The success of each program

depends directly on the behavior of each participant. The following procedures will be followed if a participant misbehaves or breaks the rules. This

procedure is used as a guideline, however, steps may be skipped if the situation warrants and will be up to the discretion of the Program Coordinator of each program.

Program Participants: Parent cooperation and involvement is vital to the successful implementation of our discipline policy. We ask the parents read and discuss the rules and policies to the participants. Parents must realize that their child's behavior may determine what the staff allows him/her to do while participating in the programs. Please answer any questions the child may have regarding your expectations as well as our behavior policies.

Immediate Dismissal: The Barnstable Recreation Division reserves the right to remove and suspend a participant from a program if they pose serious

continual discipline problems, especially those in which their behavior endangers the safety of themselves or others, whether or not all of the steps in our discipline procedure have been completed.

Immediate Dismissal Examples:

Any child who brings a weapon to a program (knife, blade, gun, explosive device, etc.) will be immediately removed from the program.

Any child who seriously harms himself or another participant will be removed (physical and/or verbal abuse).

Any child who makes a credible threat to hurt themselves or other participants will be removed.

Any child who verbally or physically abuses staff will be removed.

Documentation: All behavioral issues will be documented and may warrant an Incident Report. If needed, an Incident Report will be immediately

completed by the staff and submitted and reviewed by the Recreation Director and Assistant Recreation Director.

Suspensions: The staff would like program participants to have the best experience possible while participating in our programs. The staff will use a caring and positive approach with regards to discipline. The staff will differentiate discipline and use of corrective action (e.g., positive reinforcement, firm

statements, and redirection) in working with the participants to use appropriate and positive behavior while enrolled in our programs. Although the staff is committed to correct inappropriate behavior, suspensions may be necessary for repeat offenses or in the instance of a severe infraction. Listed below are the infractions (minor and major) and actions that will be taken.

Minor Infractions:

Disrespectful to staff members or participants

Not listening and/or following directions

Swearing

Inappropriate gestures

Breaking general program rules

Action Taken (under the discretion of the Recreation Division):

Verbal warning and correction of behavior

Written warning - notification to parent/guardian if participant is a minor

1-3 day suspension

1-2 week suspension with a final warning

Expulsion from the program

Major Infractions:

Hitting/Biting/Spitting

Stealing

Possession of weapon

Threatening staff or other participants

Action Taken (under the discretion of the Recreation Division):

Indefinite suspension

Expulsion

Barnstable Recreation Parent's Code of Conduct

The Barnstable Recreation Division has adopted the following Parent's Code of Conduct for programs, activities, and events. Youth sports/activities can be used as an opportunity for your child to learn how to engage in healthy competition while maintaining respect for their opponents.

All parties attending our programs/activities/events should adhere to the highest standard of positive support for the participants. By participating in

Barnstable Recreation programs, all parties must abide by the Parent's Code of Conduct. Violations may result in the loss of privileges at programs,

activities, and/or events.

I (and my guests) will be a positive role model for my children and encourage sportsmanship by showing respect and courtesy, and by demonstrating positive support for all players, staff, coaches, officials and spectators at every game, practice or program event. I (and my guests) will not engage in any kind of unsportsmanlike conduct with any staff, officials, coaches, player or parents. This conduct could

include booing, taunting, refusing to shake hands, or using profane language or gestures.

I will respect the staff/officials and their authority. I will refrain from questioning, discussing or confronting staff/officials during the games, and will take time to speak with the staff/officials at an agreed upon time and place.

I will remember that children participate to have fun and that the program is for the youths, not the adults.

I will demand a program environment for my child that is free from drugs and alcohol and will refrain from their use at all youth sports events.

I realize that the purpose of my attendance is to observe a program and support recreation activities, not a license to verbally assault others or be

generally obnoxious.

I will respect the athletic facility in which I am visiting and will not damage or deface town or school property. I have read and understand the Code of Conduct and consent to abide by all listed terms.
