The Town of Barnstable assumes no responsibility for the safety of the vessel moored on the mooring and will not be liable for fire, theft, or damage to said vessel and/or mooring, its equipment or any property in or on said vessel. Mooring owner agrees that the mooring of any vessel shall be at his or her own risk and that he or she should have the boat insured by complete marine coverage to cover the risk including liability for damage he or she may cause to other vessels or property.

It is the responsibility of the individual to periodically inspect all chafing gear on the mooring pennants to ensure protection for storms. The Town of Barnstable will not be responsible for the vessel going adrift or ashore.

A second vessel of the same or lesser length, draft, and size may be permitted as a <u>Secondary</u> <u>Vessel</u> at the discretion of the Harbormasters Office. Such vessel must be owned by the mooring permit holder. This in no way would allow for an additional mooring, only the use of the mooring by an alternate vessel permitted by the Harbormasters Office. Only one vessel may be attached to the mooring at one time and rafting shall be forbidden.
