Opioid Abatement Funding – Round Two Small Grant Application Information

Deadline for submission: Tuesday, March 31, 2025 at 5:00 PM

The Town of Barnstable is requesting applications for Opioid Abatement funding from public or private, state and federally recognized nonprofit organizations, agencies, partnerships, or other interested parties to provide services, programs, or initiatives that will mitigate the impacts of the Opioid epidemic.

The Town of Barnstable is pleased to announce the availability of Opioid Abatement Funds to support local initiatives that aim to make a positive impact on the community. Town of Barnstable based projects will be considered for grant awards from \$1,000 up to \$10,000. Projects must serve residents of the Town of Barnstable and deliver services in the areas of substance use prevention/education, harm reduction, treatment services, or recovery supports.

Rolling applications for these small grants will be reviewed by a selection committee appointed by the Town of Barnstable's Opioid Settlement Fund Working Group which will ratify grant selections. Determinations will be announced at a future Town Council Meeting following the Working Group meeting.
