### **Subject:** FY27 Notice of Funding Availability – Opioid Settlement Funds

The Town of Barnstable, in partnership with Advocates for Human Potential, Inc. (AHP), is pleased to announce the release of the FY27 Notice of Funding Availability (NOFA). This funding opportunity, supported by the Town's Opioid Settlement Funds (OSF), is intended to address the ongoing public health impact of the opioid overdose crisis.

The OSF are designed to support programs and initiatives that prevent opioid misuse, reduce individual and community harm, expand access to treatment and recovery services, and aid families and individuals affected by opioid use disorder. Through this NOFA, the Town seeks to invest in evidence-based interventions and promising programs that mitigate opioid-related harm and strengthen local capacity to respond effectively to substance use needs.
