November is a big month for Sandy Neck's Resiliency project. Some major changes are coming that are going to affect much of the access to Sandy Neck. Starting on November 12th, there will be no access to the Off Road Vehicle Beach. Why? The entire gatehouse is being relocated! To keep our patrons safe during this time we will close the area down until this phase is complete. Once the Gatehouse is relocated, the ORV may open for access on the weekends. You may visit the Sandy Neck website for access updates.

Of course, the parking lot will be closed during the fall/winter as there is no parking lot. There will be very limited parking at the gatehouse for those wishing to hike the marsh. Due to the parking restriction, we suggest exploring other hiking options around town.

Horseback riding at Sandy Neck will not be feasible at this time due to the limited parking. Horseback riding will return in the spring once we can accommodate. In addition to this, fat tire bikes can access the marsh trail, but there will be very limited parking so it is suggested to finding alternative areas to bike.

We thank our patron for their understanding and support during this time as we know how important Sandy Neck to so many people. We're excited to show all the progress we've made this coming spring!

Hunting Season

Due to the ongoing resiliency project, hunting at Sandy Neck will be greatly limited.

The last day for pheasant stocking at Sandy Neck will be the 11th of November. After this date, West Barnstable Conservation Area will be stocked with more birds once we can no longer accommodate hunting activities for the remainder of the 2025 Pheasant season.

The deer hunt at Sandy Neck will be postponed due to the ongoing construction as well.
