The Department Of Public Works is seeking funding in the amount of \$816,793 for improvements to the Centerville playground.

The playground does not meet current safety standards with worn, out of date wooden structures that need replacement.

Improvements would include:

- Community playground development workshops.
- The playground should reflect the character of the community.
- New accessible playground equipment.
- New accessible access path.
- Installation of compliant surfacing.
- Grading to fill 3 or 4 feet of the existing hollow to create an accessible path.
- Seating / Shade
- Landscaping
- Water bottle filling station

This work is the first phase of a multi-phase approach to improvements at the site.

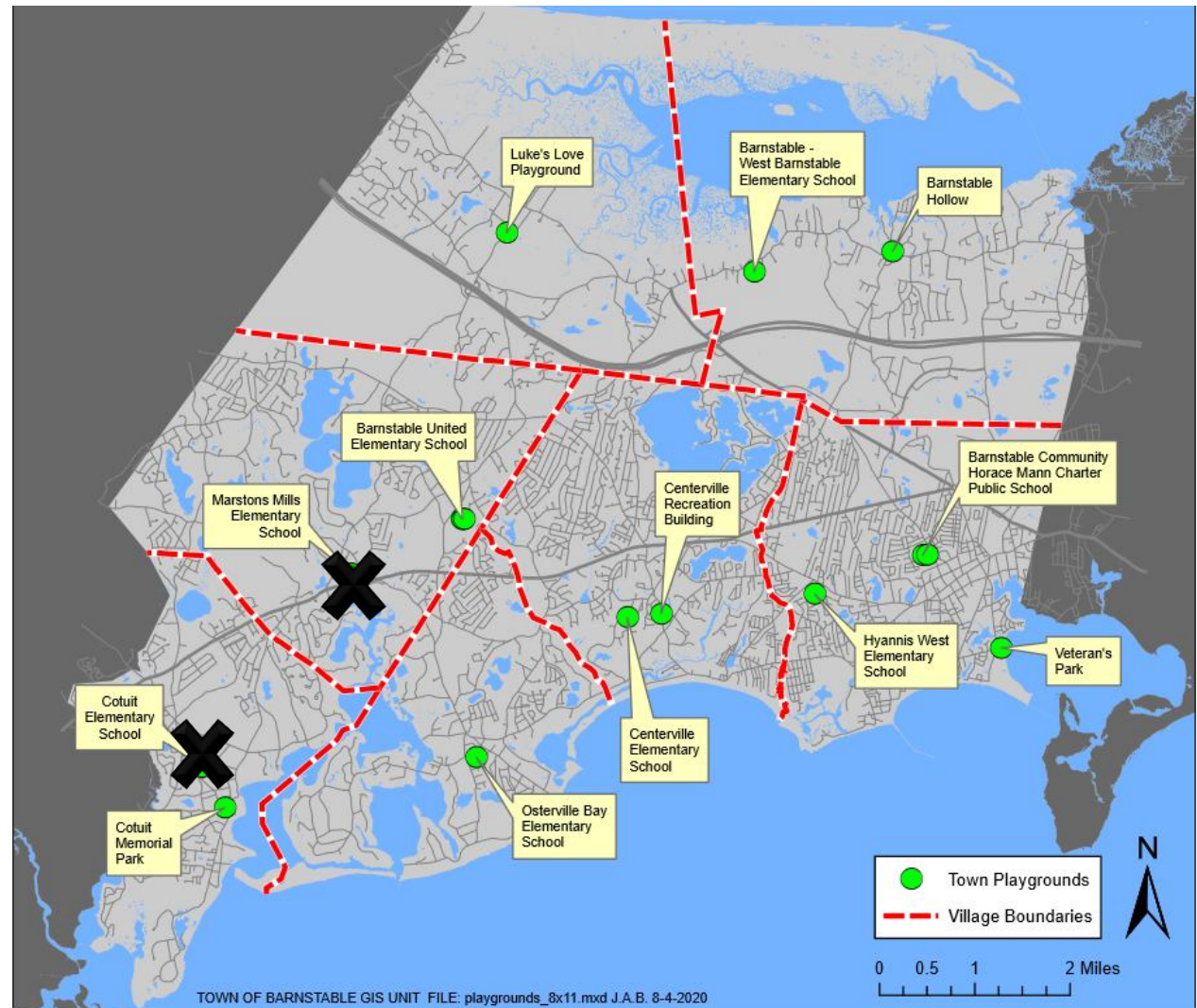


Barnstable Playgrounds

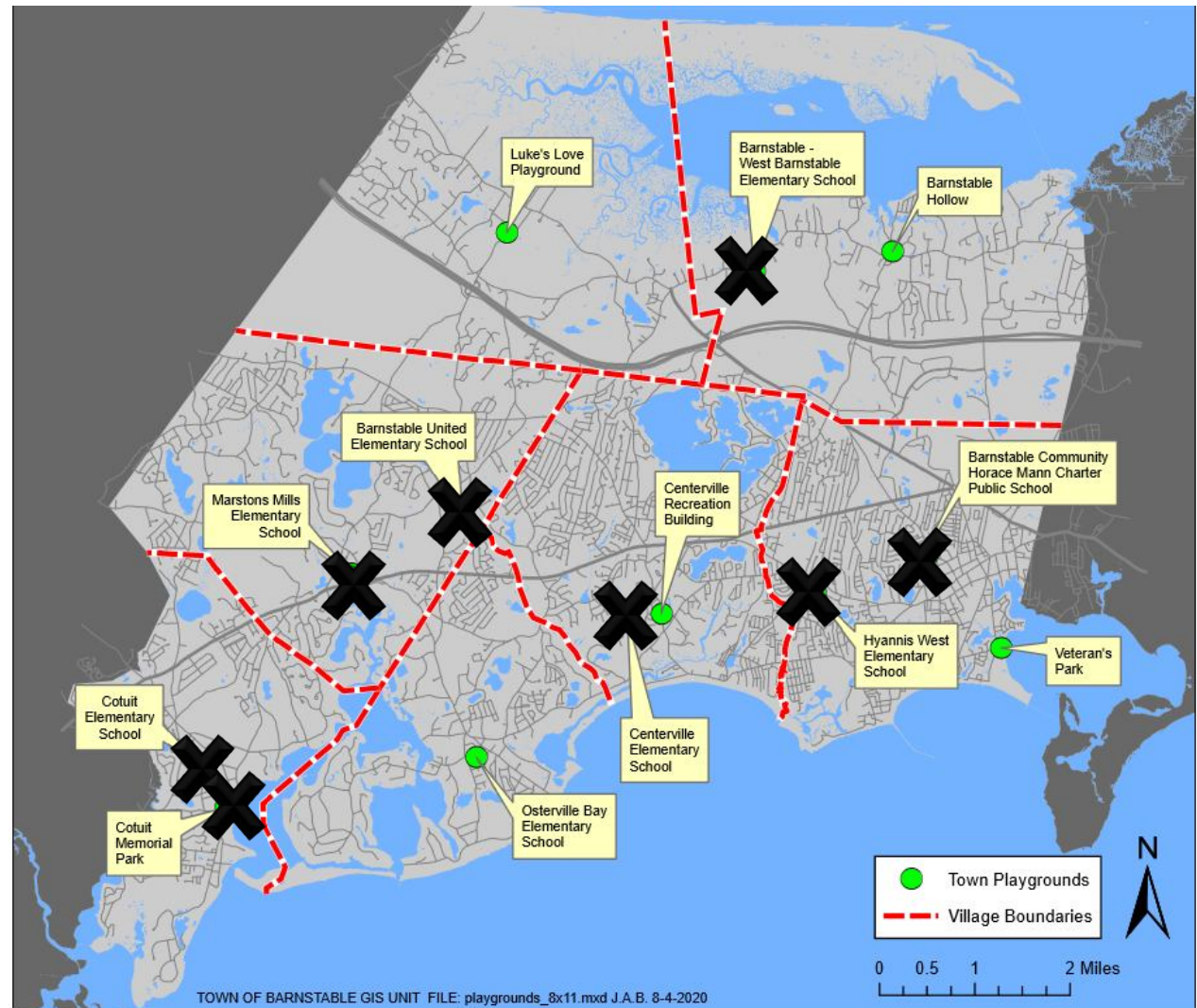


There are 11 playgrounds located throughout the 7 Villages of Barnstable.

Benefits of this location

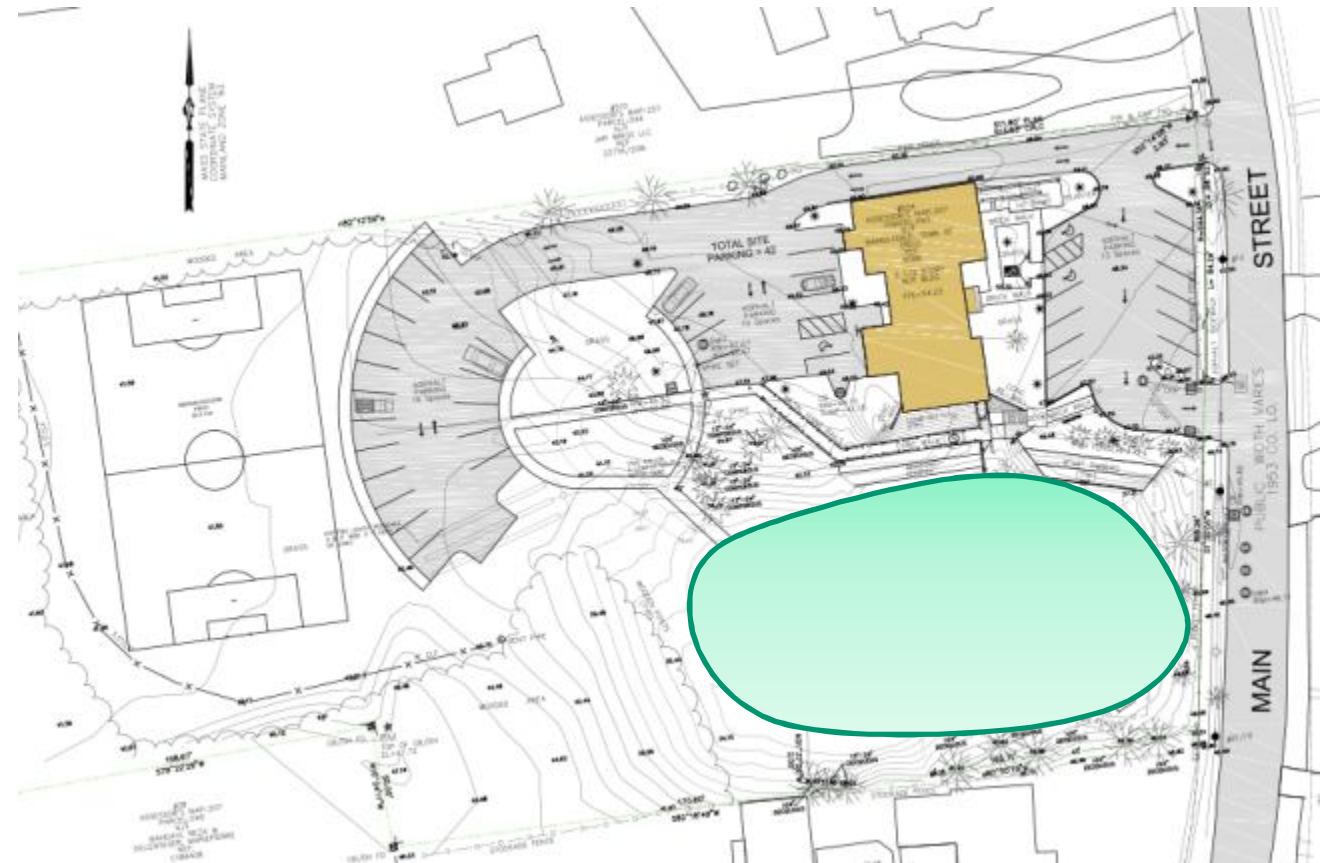
Centrally located in the center of the village

Play area contained within a defined area.





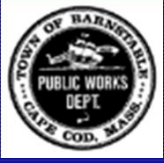

Existing Conditions



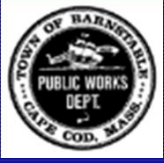
- The playground is not accessible

Centerville Playground Existing Conditions



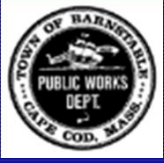

- Increased visitation to surrounding businesses.

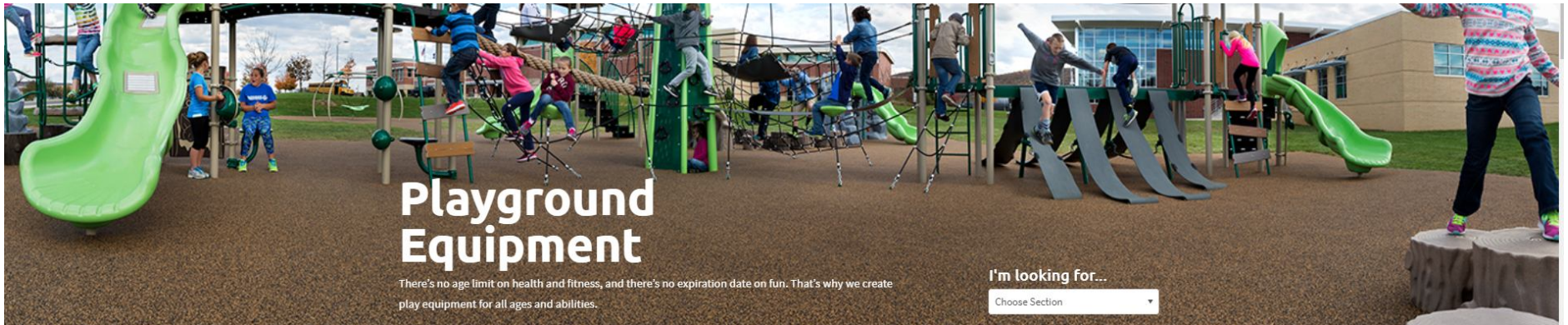


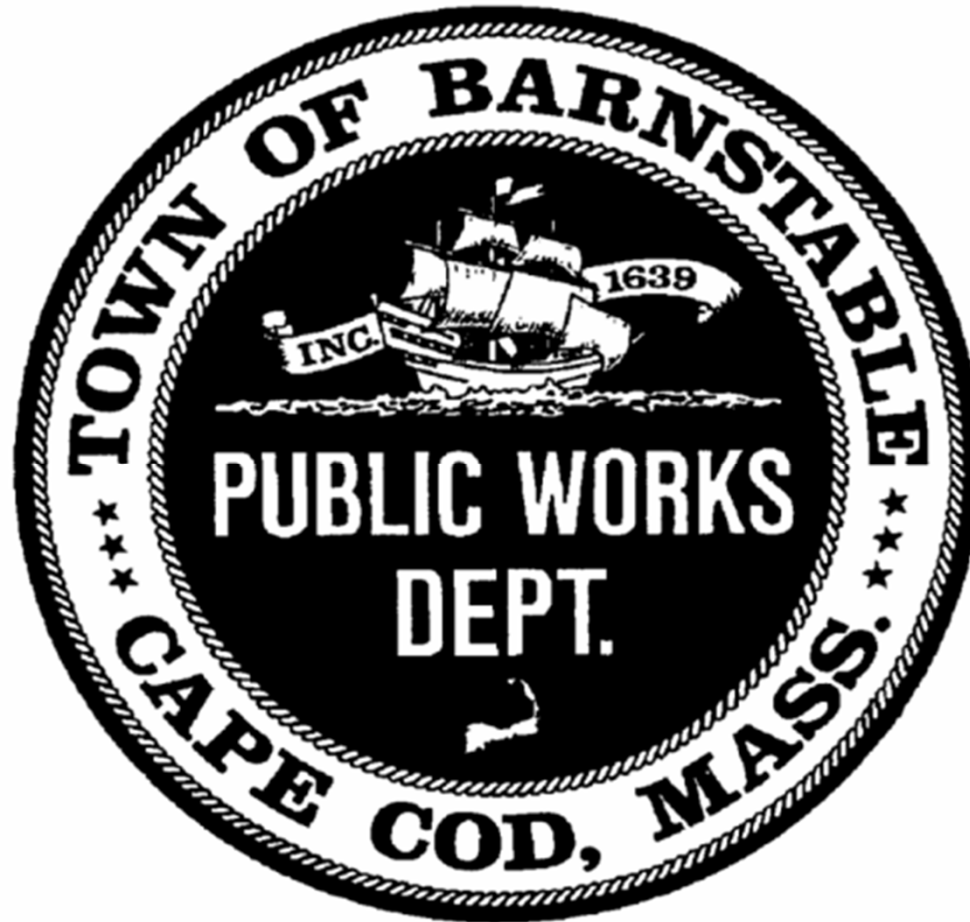
