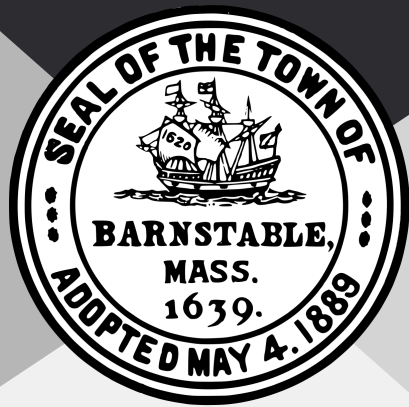



Saint John Paul II - tbd

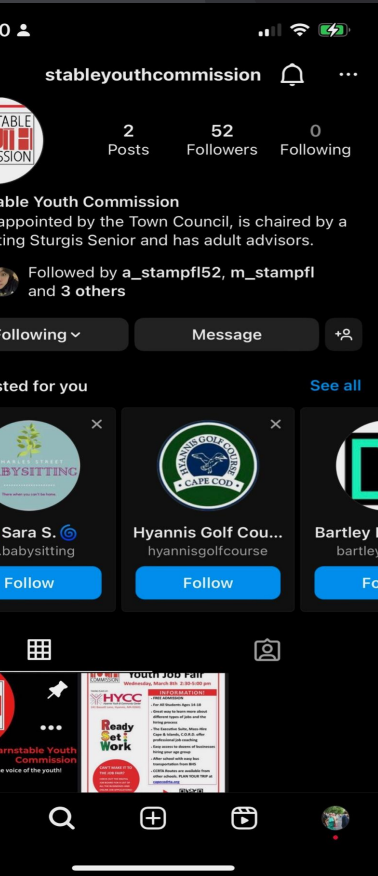
Sturgis Charter School - Sophomore students
