




Cape Cod Rail Trail Phase 3 Implementation


Project Details:

- Construction anticipated for 2024 - 2026
- Approximately 4 miles
- Will follow a combination of an existing and a newly constructed shared-use path from Peter Homer Park to Mary Dunn Road
- \$12 million estimated construction cost
 - MassDOT state-funded, committed



Cape Cod Rail Trail Phase 4 Implementation

Proposed Route for Cape Cod Rail Trail Extension Phase 4



Project Details:

- Targeting construction by 2030
- Approximately 10 miles
- Proposed route will involve some trail sections alongside roads and other sections further offset from roads so trail users will have opportunities to travel through natural areas where feasible
- Construction anticipated to occur in segments; subsequent segments will ultimately extend the trail to the Barnstable/Sandwich town line
- \$20 million estimated construction cost
 - Commitment anticipated via MassDOT
