
Security Modernization Project

Barnstable Police Facility
FY26 Capital Budget Request

Purpose: Analog to Digital Cameras:

- Upgrade and consolidate BPD's security cameras located at 1200 Phinney's Lane
- Move from analog cameras to digital cameras
- Increase coverage area
- Increase number of cameras recording activity and being monitored by a camera system
- Current analog cameras produce poor quality facial images and do not enable a face to be recognized





Address Security Concerns:

- Vital to security that police facility has a high level of security technology
- Building holds weapons, property/records, and forensic equipment
- Building is in operation 24/7/365
- Ensure safe working environment for police personnel
- Provides security monitoring at all facility entrances and exits and all parking lots

Expense and Timeline:

- Cost of upgrades to a digital camera system: \$189,000
 - Price includes purchase of cameras, installation, removal of old cameras and cabling from analog system; and storage
 - In total we will be purchasing 52 digital cameras
