The blooms can be blue, bright green, brown, or red. Blooms sometimes look like paint floating on the water's surface.

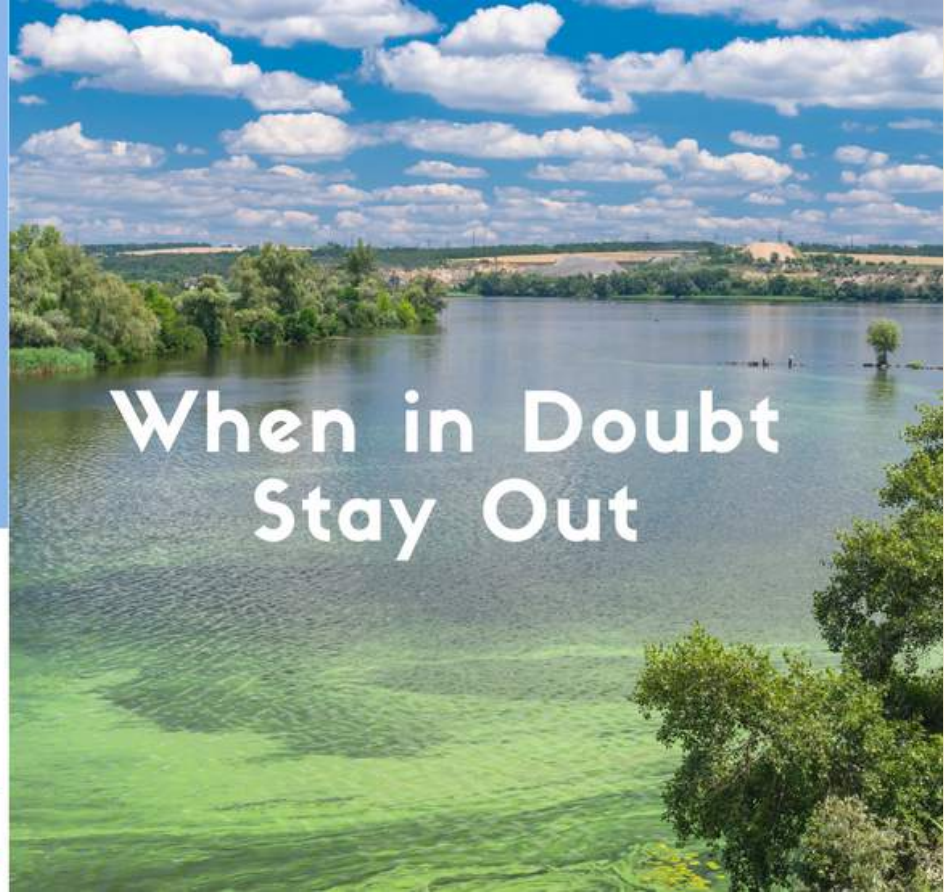

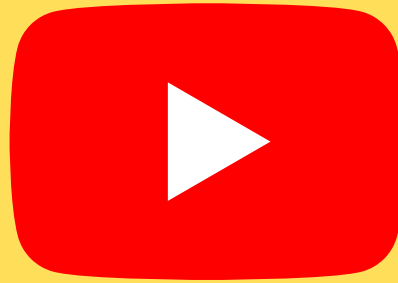
