Horizontal Directional Drilling on Route 28

Starting Monday, December 19th,
horizontal directional drilling will occur at the
intersection of Route 28 and Strawberry Hill Road.
Strawberry Hill Road from West Main Street
to Route 28 and from Route 28 to Wequaquet Lane
will need to be closed to accommodate this work.
Traffic on Route 28 will not require a detour.


