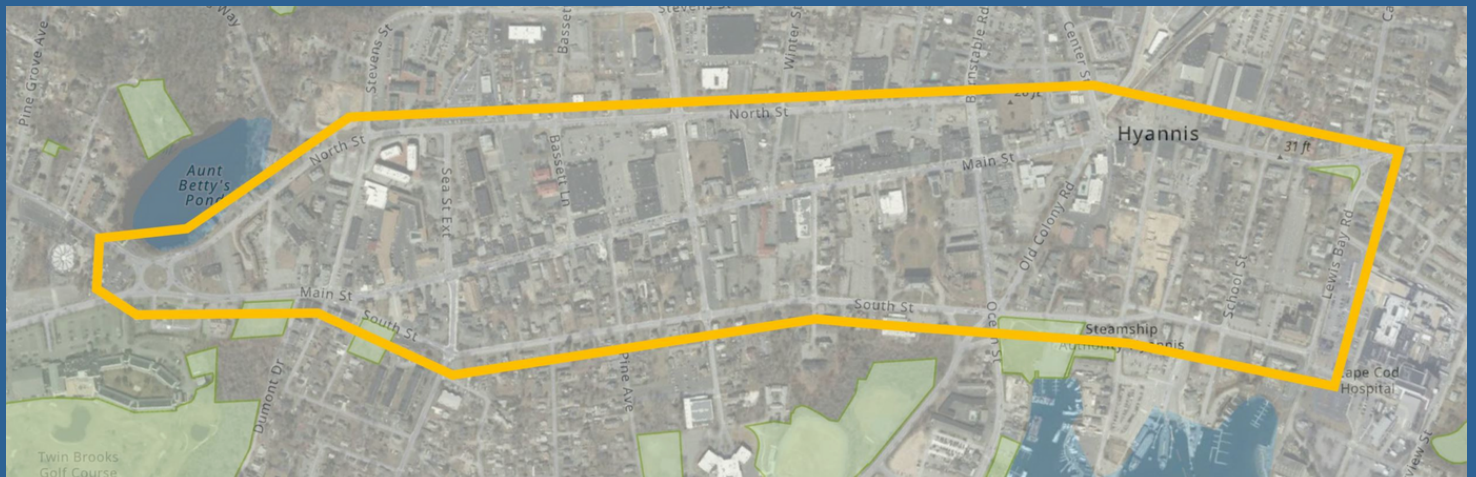

How can you help?

Please stake your property

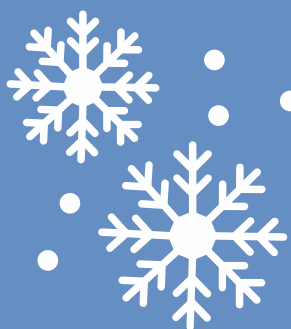
One of the important things you can do to help our plow drivers is stake the edge of your properties with plow stakes/reflectors.

- Plow stakes can be wood or fiberglass with reflectors on top or wrapped around the body of the stake. The reflective material needs to be high enough up the stake that it can be seen over the snow drift.
- The stakes should be driven into the ground as close to the edge of the property as possible. Generally we recommend placing them every 8-10 feet.
- Installing stakes is easier before the ground freezes, it is recommended you do it sooner rather than later.

Please follow the advice of public safety officials

When a driving ban is put into effect, it is for your protection. Please stay off the roads until given the all clear notice.

- Make certain your vehicle is ready for winter driving.
- Reduce your speed. This is the number one cause of winter accidents.
- Please give plows and sanders the right of way and stay at least 50 feet back from each.
