

Town Manager Grant of Location Hearing was held Wednesday July 12th

These regulations provide application procedures and standards for the placement of wireless communication facilities in the public rights of way. The purpose of these regulations is to provide a uniform and comprehensive set of objective procedures and standards for the location, placement, installation, height, appearance and operation of personal wireless service facilities in the public ways to meet the needs of residents, business owners and visitors, while protecting public health and safety and the aesthetic character of the community, consistent with applicable state and federal requirements.

The Community Preservation Act (CPA) is a state law passed in 2000 that allows Massachusetts communities to conduct a referendum to add a small surcharge on local property taxes.

When combined with matching funds from the statewide Community Preservation Trust Fund, this dedicated fund is used to build and rehabilitate parks, playgrounds, and recreational fields, protect open space, support local affordable housing development, and preserve historic buildings and resources.

The Community Preservation Committee is seeking public input on how this CPA funding source should be utilized for Fiscal Year 2024.


