

The Boating Safety Seven

1.Wear your life jacket
2.Take a boating safety class
3.Carry all required safety gear
4.Use your engine cut-off switch
5.File a float plan
6.Be aware of weather and water conditions

Practice the 3 Cs of Boating Safety <u>CAUTION, COURTESY, AND COMMON SENSE</u>

7.Boat sober, and be considerate of others

- Use <u>CAUTION</u>, especially in close quarter maneuvering situations with other boats. In such situations, slow speeds are better.
- Be <u>COURTEOUS</u> to your fellow boaters.

Use <u>COMMON</u> sense. Don't cut people off at the launch ramp, and never light Fireworks from your boat!


