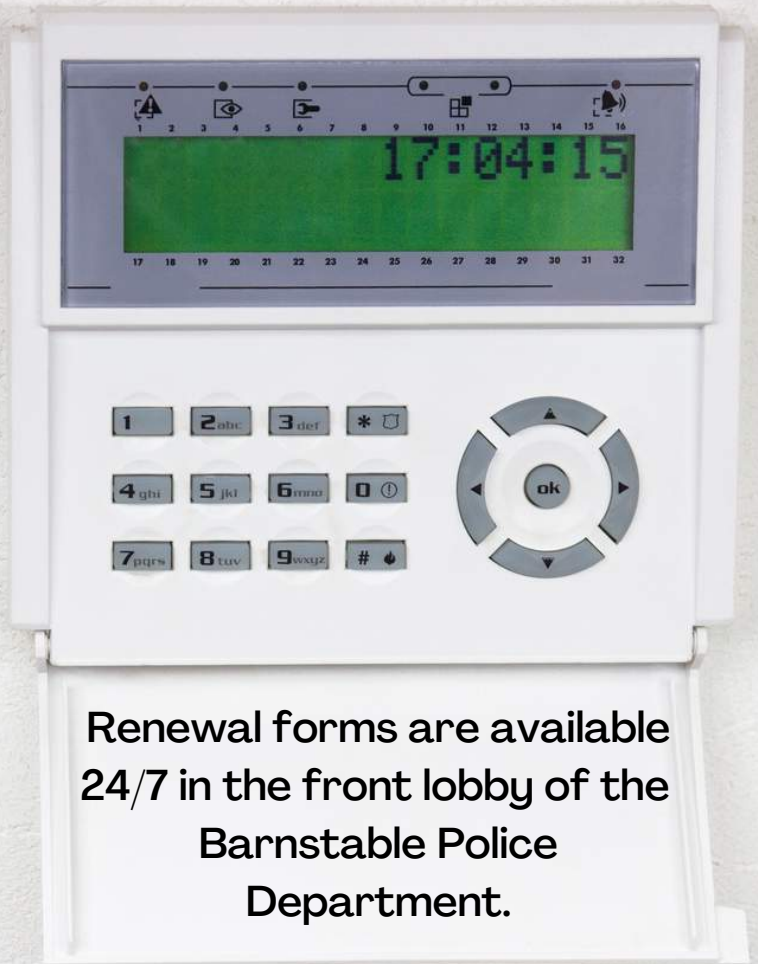
## TIME TO RENEW YOUR BURGLAR ALARM REGISTRATION WITH THE BARNSTABLE POLICE DEPARTMENT

All burglar alarm registrations within the Town of Barnstable will expire on December 31, 2022.

If you own a house or business in the Town of Barnstable that is equipped with an active burglar alarm, monitored or non-monitored, you need to renew your Alarm Registration and get your 2023/2024 decal.

Due to limited parking at our Bay St. landing, we ask that any shellfish permit holders refrain from parking in the NO PARKING zones, which include both sides of the road, and park in the areas designated on the map in yellow.

These designated areas include Bay Street up to the residence at 146, marked spaces on Main Street and in town-owned lots located at 818 Main Street and 9 Wianno Ave.

We ask that you drop off your gear at the landing and then park your vehicle and walk down. Should you park in a NO PARKING zone, you may receive a citation and fine up to \$40.00. Police will be assisting with Parking Management of this area on Saturday, 11/5, and Sunday, 11/6
