





SNOW AND ICE CONTRACTORS WANTED



SAFETY FIRST, BARNSTABLE!



It's important to note the date changes to when a **LIFEJACKET MUST BE WORN**

Wearing a properly fitted life jacket (personal flotation device) could save your life. Most boating fatality victims were not wearing a life jacket. In Massachusetts, life jackets must be worn by:

- Canoeists and kayakers from **September 15 - May 15** (including waterfowl hunters)
- Youth under 12 years old
- Personal watercraft users
- Waterskiers

WEAR A LIFE JACKET

It is recommended that you wear a life jacket every time you are on the water. Accidents on the water often happen too quickly to reach and put on a stowed life jacket.

Offseason Transient Dockage Information from Harbormaster's Office

The rates for residents and non-residents are reduced at two of our busiest town marinas. Barnstable Harbor and Prince Cove. These offseason reduced rates run from September 15th to October 27th and are a great way for the public to enjoy transient dockage at a reduced rate. Slip availability is subject to change. 


Mid-Cape Cultural Council Funding Priorities Community Survey
